## (3.0) ELIG1BILITY REQUIREMENTS

Prospective Bidders must possess the under listed requirements to be eligible in this procurement.

- (i) Evidence of certificate of incorporation issued by Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Forms CAC2 and CAC7 (or CAC 1.1)
- (ii) Evidence of company's current Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years, 2017, 2018, and 2019 expired 31 December, 2020; with minimum turn annual average turnover of N20 Million.
- (iii) Evidence of current pension compliance certificate valid till 31 December, 2020
- (iv) Evidence of current industrial Training Fund (ITF) compliance certificate valid till 31 December. 2020.
- (v) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) compliance certificate valid till 31 December, 2020.
- (vi) Evidence of registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31 December, 2020 or valid certificate issued by BPP;
- (vii) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committee of the Federal Government Girls' College, Gboko, Benue State or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a formal to or present Directors, shareholders or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
- (a) That the company is not in receivership, insolvent or bankrupt
- (b) That the company does not have any Director who has been convicted in any court in Nigeria or any other country for criminal offences in relation to fraud or financial impropriety.

- (viii) Company's audited accounts for the last three years 2017,2018 and 2019 duly signed and stamped by ICAN/ANAN profession(s).
- (ix) Company's profile with the curriculum vitae of key staff to be deployed for the project including copies of their Academic/professional qualifications such as C0REN, OSRBN. ARCON, CORBON, etc.
- (x) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of reference letter from a reputable Commercial Bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed.
- (xi) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including letters of Awards, valuation certificates, completion certificate and photographs of the projects
- (xii) List of plants/equipment with proof of ownership/least (where applicable)
