(e) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2019;

(f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 30/6/2019 or valid certificate issued by BPP;

(g) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any Officer of the relevant committees of the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director shareholder or has any pecuniary Interest in the bidder and to confirm that all Information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

(h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2016, 2017 and 2018);

(i) Evidence of Financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, Indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;

(j) Company Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications (e.g. COREN, QSRBN, ARGON, CORBON, etc.);

(k) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar Jobs in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Interim Payment/ Valuation Certificates and Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the project;

(I) List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease;

(m) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (all the eligibility requirements are compulsory for each JV partner;

(n) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a covering/ Forwarding letter under the Company's/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the names and Nationalities of the Directors of the company at the bottom of the page, duty signed by the authorized officer off the firm.

(ii) Interested bidders should note that the original of the documents listed above would be requested and should be available for sighting, whenever required. Also, the bidding documents of any bidder that do not meet the above eligibility criteria will not be considered.

(1) COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

(4) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
