(1.0) INTRODUCTION:

(3) Evidence of current Pension Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2020;

(4) Evidence of current Industrial Trust Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2020;

(5) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2020;

(6) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 30th June. 2020 or valid Certificate issued by BPP;

(7) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant Committees of the Federal Polytechnic Nekede, Owerri or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, Shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

(8) Company's Audited Accounts for the last 3 (three) years (i.e. 2017, 2018 & 2019);

(9) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a Reputable Commercial Bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;

(10) Company Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their academic/professional qualifications;

(11) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least 3 (three) similar jobs executed in the last 5 (five) years (i.e. from 2014 to 2019), including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;

(12) Evidence of Financial Capability to execute the project by submission of reference letters from a reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;

(13) List of Plants/Equipment with Proof of Ownership/Lease (where applicable);

(14) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) should be provided (all the eligibility requirements are compulsory for each JV partner);

(15) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM number), and an email address.
