(1) INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE OF WORK

(3) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- (b) Evidence of company Income's Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2018, with minimum average turnover of N50 million;
- (c) Evidence of current Pension Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2018;
- (d) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2018;
- (e) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2018;
- (f) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 1/1/2019 or valid Certificate issued by BPP;
- (g) Sworn affidavit affirming that none of the officers of the World Bank, Bayero University, Kano or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director or Stakeholder or has pecuniary interest in the bidder and that all the information being provided by the Company are true and correct in all particulars;

- (h) Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2015, 2016 & 2017;
- (i) Letter of authorisation from Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEM): this is applicable for the Lots under 'Batch A: Goods' only;
- (j) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed:
- (k) Company Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/ Professional qualifications;
- (I) Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- (m) List of Plants/Equipment with proof of Ownership/Lease (where applicable);
- (n) For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided;
- (o) Letter of Consent to allow for verification of all documents submitted:
- (p) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/ Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

Interested companies are to collect the Standard Bidding Document (SBD) from the office of the Director, Procurement, New Campus, Bayero University, Kano on evidence of payment of a non-refundable fee of N 10,000.00 per Lot, paid into the Bayero University, Kano's Remita account in any commercial bank.

(5) SUBMISSION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Prospective bidders are to submit bid for each of the Lot desired, two (2) hard copies each of the technical and financial bids with softcopy of financial bid only in MS Excel format, packaged separately in sealed envelopes and clearly marked as "Technical Bid" or "Financial Bid.
