- (iv) Verifiable evidence of certificate of compliance with National Pension Commission (PENCOM)
- (v) Verifiable evidence of certificate of compliance with National Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF)
- (vi) Verifiable evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) certificate of clearance

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- (vii) Verifiable evidence of a sworn affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of NIFFR or BPP is a Director of the company
- (viii) Verifiable evidence of previous job experience in similar jobs for the past three (3) years
- (ix) Verifiable evidence of Financial competence

- (x) Verifiable evidence of Company Profile indicating detailed CV's of key company staff
- (xi) Verifiable evidence of list of equipment to be used for the project and their locations (where applicable)
- (xii) List of key Personnel/Officers attached to the Project and their qualifications, photocopies of professional certificate as well as evidence that none of the company's Directors has been convicted of any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation, falsification of fact relating to any matter.
