(iv) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund Compliance Certificate expiring on 31st December, 2018;

(v) Evidence of current Nigerian Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) compliance certificate expiring on 31st December, 2018;

(vi) Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 1/1/2019 or valid Certificate issued by BPP;

(vii) A sworn affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the Veterinary Council of Nigeria or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.

(viii) List and verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs in the last five (B) years including Letter of Awards, Valuation Certificate and Job Completion Certificate;

(ix) Company's Profile with including curriculum Vitae of Key Staff with copies of their Professional Qualifications.

(x) Bank reference indicating the Bank's readiness to support the funding of the project if awarded;

(xi) Audited Accounts of the bidder for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016, 2017);

(xii) Only companies included in the National Automotive Design and Development Council's approved list of local manufacturers of vehicles or their authorised representative should bid for lot 5.
