These documents shall be dropped in Tender Boxes marked "Technical" and "Commercial" which shall be supplied for this purpose in the Central Administration Office Block. Room 36.

7. Opening of pre-qualification documents:

The Technical and Commercial bids shall be opened after 12 noon on 22nd September, 2014 in the University Senate Chambers. All bidders are expected to attend. Interested members of the public and journalist are invited to witness the ceremony of the bids. After the opening of the documents the Technical bids shall be analyses by the University Technical Committee. Only the pre-qualified contractors shall have their commercial bids analyzed for subsequent award.
