Maternal and Newborn Child Health 2 (MNCH2) Invitation for Pre-Qualification

Background

The Maternal, New-born and Child Health Program (MNCH2) is a country led program which aims to reduce maternal and child mortality in Northern Nigeria and it is funded by the Department for International Development (DFID). The MNCH2 programme is being implemented in six states in northern Nigeria: Jigawa, Kaduna, Katsina, Kano, Yobe and Zamfara States.

MNCH2 is calling for qualified construction and engineering firms in related areas to indicate interest in renovations of health facilities, LGA medical and cold stores and state medical and cold stores in the above mentioned states. Interested bidders are therefore requested to submit prequalification documents and requirements as listed below.

- (vi) Verifiable evidence of current Pension Commission (PENCOM) compliance certificate
- (vii) Verifiable evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) compliance certificate

(b) Other Criteria

(i) Evidence of Financial Capability and Banking Support (Bank Reference letter, Recent Statement of Account).

(ii) Experiences/Technical Qualification and experience of key personnel (Company Profile, CV and Credentials of personnel).

(iii) Evidence of "Similar Projects" executed over the last five (5) years and evidence of knowledge of the industry (Award letters of projects executed and certificates of practical completion).

(iv) List and Sources of Equipment and Technology Capacity (Evidence of ownership/ Lease agreement)

(v) List of completed and On-going Projects (if any)

(vi) Relevant information concerning means of contact, e.g Telephone, E-mail address etc of company and responsible person

Note: – Original copies of documents listed above must be produced for sighting after being prequalified, before collection of Tender Documents.
