(1) INTRODUCTION

The Women for Health (W4H) Programme is funded and supported by UKaid under the Department for international Development (DFID), with the mission of increasing the number of female health workers to reduce maternal mortality during child birth. In fulfillment of their mission, renovations/upgrading works will be carried out in some selected health training institutions in 5 (five) states in the northern parts of the country' comprising Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Yobe and Zamfara States. (2) PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

(a) Each Contractor is expected to submit the following documents

- (i) Evidence of Incorporation with Corporate affairs Commission (CAC).
- (ii) Evidence of most recent Tax Clearance Certificate for the year ending 2015
- (iii) Company Audited Accounts for three (3) years (2013, 2014 & 2015)
- (iv) Security deposit of 1,500,000,00 Naira in form of draft check from a commercial Bank payable to Grid Consultants
- (v) Covering letter indicating ONLY 2 locations that the bidder proposes to work

(b) Other Criteria

- (i) Evidence of Financial Capability and Banking Support (Bank Reference letter, Statement of Account for the last 3
- (ii) Experiences / Technical Qualification of key personnel (Company Profile, CV and Credentials of personnel).
- (iii) Evidence of “Similar Projects” executed over the last five (5) years
- (iv) Evidence of knowledge of the industry (Award letters of projects executed and Certificates of Practical Completion etc.).
- (v) VAT Registration (TIN Number) and evidence of past VAT remittances
- (vi) List of completed and On-going Projects (if any)
- (vii) Relevant information concerning means of contacts, e.g. Telephone, E-mail address etc. of company and responsible person.

Note: – After being pre- qualified, original copies of documents listed above must be produced for sighting before collection of Tender Documents.

(3) SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

The pre-qualification documents should be addressed to the **Finance & Admin Manager, W4H National Office, 1, Adantu Dankabo Close, Off Tukur Road, Nassarawa G.R.A, Kano** and submitted in sealed envelopes and clearly marked “**Pre–qualification to tender for the project (name of the School and the State)**”. **All documents should be submitted not later than 10:00AM on Thursday, 26th May, 2016.** Opening of submissions will commence immediately after at 11:00am.
