# Invitation for Pre-Qualification of Prospective Contractors to Renovate Flagship Primary Health Centres

The Lagos State Government recently developed a policy on Primary Health Care revitalization with a view to improve provision of quality, affordable and sustainable basic health care to the people.

Towards the implementation of this new policy, it has become necessary to rehabilitate the existing Primary Health Centres, starting with the newly designated 57 flagship Primary Health Centres that provide 24 hours services.

The State Government, through the Ministry- of Health and the Primary Health Care Board, has developed a plan to renovate the 57 flagship Primary Health Centres in phases and in the light of this, reputable contractors are hereby invited for pre-qualification to bid for the renovation projects.

### **General Instructions**

i. Interested contractors are required to obtain a pre-qualification form the office of the Lagos State Primary Health Care Board: Block 4, Room 519, Ministry of Health, The Secretariat, Alausa-Ikeja.

ii. Failure to submit all the required documents may lead to disqualification. Contractors should note that the Lagos State Government reserves the right to seek verification from relevant authorities concerning any document or information submitted for pre-qualification.

iii. Please note that this is an Invitation to Pre-Qualify as a Bidder, and only qualified bidders would be eligible to bid for the projects.

#### 3. Submission of Pre-Qualification Documents:

Applications for pre-qualification to tender shall be made by completing the pre-qualification form and submitting the under-listed documents to the above-stated address.

- i. Certificate of incorporation obtained from Corporate Affairs Commission.
- ii. Evidence of registration with the Lagos State Tenders Board,
- iii. Tax clearance for the last 3 years.
- iv. Evidence of financial capability and banking support.
- v. Company profile, including the names of key professional staff and their resume.
- vi. Relevant and verifiable projects executed in last 5 years, with means of verification.
- vii. Evidence of availability of relevant equipment and technical capacity.

Closing date for the submission and receipt of pre-qualification documents is on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2011.
