Invitation to Tender for Goods and Works Projects

(1.0) Introduction

The Federal College of Fisheries and Marine Technology, Victoria Island, Lagos, a parastatal under the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development invites interested, competent, suitable and reliable vendors with relevant experience to tender for the following 2016 Capital Projects:-

(2.0) SCOPE

LOT 01: Construction of 18Nos Room Students' hostel in Lagos.

LOT 02: Procurement of Nautical Science/Fishing soft and hardware training equipment with 3156 graphic hours and Master License.

LOT 03: Refurbishing and conversion of existing Aquarium building to Library Complex in Lagos.

LOT 04: Procurement of a light marine vessel with outboard engines for Artisanal Dermal fishing for students practical.

LOT 05: Procurement of GRP fishing vessel with in-board engineer, Navigational aids and marine insurance for students' practical.

LOT 06: Construction of concrete hollow block perimeter fence in Lagos.

LOT 07: Construction of 15Nos office Administrative building in Lagos.

LOT 08: Provision of industrial borehole, water treatment plant and appurtenances in Lagos.

LOT 09: Construction of steel casing 8 inches diameter Industrial borehole in Lagos.

LOT 10: Procurement of Marine Engineering Tools & Equipment for students' practical.

LOT 11: Refurbishing of hostels, Nautical Science building and Administrative building.

LOT 12: Furnishing and equipping of classrooms and offices.

LOT 13: Provision of Lecturers' Room in Lagos.

(3.0) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Interested vendors shall submit the following minimum verifiable technical requirements to be eligible for contract consideration.

- Evidence of Registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) by including Certificate of Incorporation and Article of Association.
- Detailed Company profile.
- Evidence of Registration with relevant professional bodies such as COREN, ARCON, SURCON etc. where applicable especially construction works.
- Photocopy of current tax clearance (for the last three years) corresponding with declared annual turnover.
- Compliance Certificate from National Pension Commission (Pencom Reform Act 2004).
- Evidence of Registration with Bureau of Public Procurement (Interim Registration Report)
- Audited statement of Account of the Company for the last (3) three years.
- Evidence of at least 5 similar projects executed within the last (3) three years.
- Compliance Certificate from Industrial Training Fund (ITF Amendment Act 2011) CVs of at least 5 key personnel of the Company.
- Evidence of payment of non-refundable fee N30,000.00 for tender document to Federal College of Fisheries and Marine Technology remittal account.

(4.0) COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

Tender documents can be collected from the office of Procurement Department on the ground floor of the Administrative building, Federal College of Fisheries and Marine Technology, Victoria Island, Lagos on payment of a non-refundable sum of N30,000 (Thirty thousand naira only) to Federal College of Fisheries and Marine Technology remittal account. Interested vendors can start collection of Tender Documents from 9th August, 2016 between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm daily.
