- (e) Company Profile which should include (i) Names of current Directors as registered with CAC (ii) Names, Qualification and Experience of key Personnel and (iii) List of Verifiable Projects successfully executed in the relevant area applied for pre-qualification for the immediate past three years.
- (f) Bank Reference and Statement of Account for the last 12 months (February, 2016 to January, 2017)
- (g) Certificate of compliance with Pension Reforms Act, 2004, Issued by the Pensions Commission.
- (h) Certificate of compliance with Section 6 (1) – (3) of the Industrial Training Fund Amendment Act, 2011, issued by the ITF.
- (i) “Certificate of Practice” from relevant Professional Body and evidence of up-to-date payment of Dues for Companies applying under Consultancy.
- (j) A sworn affidavit of disclose of interest that none of the Directors is a serving or retired staff of TETFund, BPP and that none of the Directors of the Firm has been convicted in any court for any criminal offence including fraud and financial impropriety,
- (k) A sworn Affidavit that the firm is not in receivership, insolvency, bankruptcy proceedings, winding up petition or proceedings and that all-information contained in the bid are true and correct.
