- Proposed Procurement and Installation of Various Equipment and Reagents for Departments of Soil Science, Animal Science, Agronomy and Agricultural Extension (Lot D)

1. Evidence of registration of company with the Corporate Affairs Commission (Only Limited Liability Company).
2. Evidence of registration with PENCOM
3. Evidence of registration with FIRS for VAT collection and TIN
4. Evidence of similar job(s) executed in the last three (3) years
5. Evidence of financial capability and possible bank support
6. Recent Three (3) Years Tax clearance Certificates
7. Evidence of compliance with the Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Act 2011 (Amended)
8. A sworn affidavit of disclose of interest that none of the Directors is a serving or retired staff of TETFund, Bureau of public procurement (BPP) and that none of the Directors of the firm has been convicted for any criminal offence relating to fraud, financial impropriety or falsification of acts relating to any matter.
9. A sworn affidavit that the firm is not in receivership, insolvency, bankruptcy proceedings, winding up petition or proceedings and that all information contained in the bids are true and correct;
10. Evidence of registration on the National Database of contractors, Consultants and services Providers (NDCCSP) provided by the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP).
11. Evidence of Audited accounts.

All Pre-qualification and Tender submissions should be in duplicate copies (marked original and copy) and in separate envelopes sealed in one (1) common envelope. All envelopes must be well sealed.
